A Big Thank You to all who helped to make the **Inaugural Recital** on Thursday evening such a resounding success, despite the organ not being fully completed. It should be finished soon!

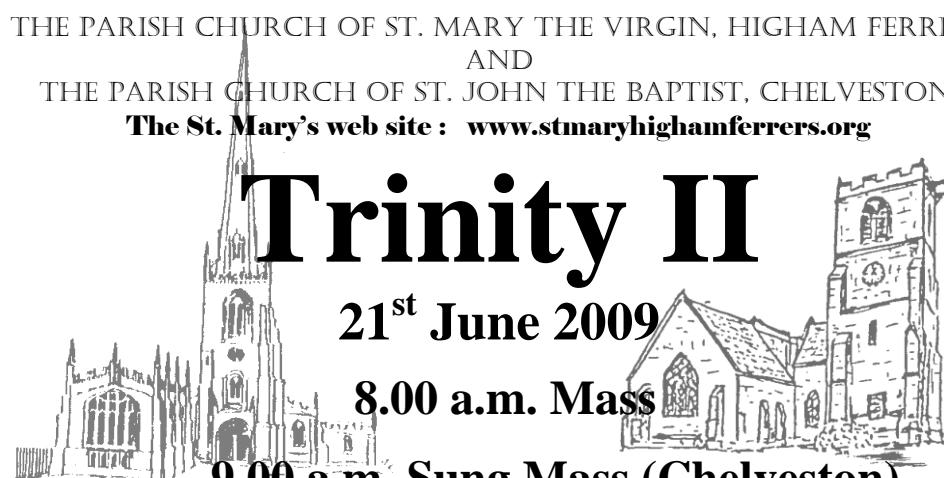
The Organ Fund now stands at **£77,000** of the **£80,000** needed. Grateful thanks to all supporters.
